The Cause of Death

*For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord
Romans 6:23.*

Most people prefer to focus on living, but death is a reality we must all face.

The bible says, “When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam’s sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned” (Rom. 5:12).

In the garden of Eden, Adam together with Eve, broke the only command God had given them: “But you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die” (Gen. 2:17).

Disobedience broke their intimacy with God and brought physical death to humanity. This is because death is payment for our sin - we earn it.

When Adam and Eve disobeyed God mankind fell from glory, and sin, sickness, death etc. plagued mankind.

Who Needs Forgiveness of Sin

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God. Rom. 3:23

As Adam’s descendants, we are born dead in our offenses and sins (Eph. 2:1), and we remain spiritually dead in our sin unless we unite with God through faith in Christ (1 Cor. 5:22).

Having explained the consequences of sin, the next question is: who is a sinner? Beloved, anyone that disobeyed God's commandments or breaks any of the moral laws (the ten commandment) is a sinner.

If you have ever broken any of the 10 commandments, then you are a sinner and require a saviour – and that saviour is only Jesus Christ.

According to the scripture, lust, drunkenness, hatred, sexual immorality, lying, stealing, idolatry, filthiness, indecent actions, witchcraft, fighting; envy, anger, ambitious, orgies etc, are all sin against God. Remember, whoever breaks one of these commandments has broken the whole commandment (James 2:10).
